Basic logo & identity guidelines

The content of this brief manual provides the basic tools and guidelines to ensure the correct use of Lethe's visual identity elements: logo, typeface and colour palette.



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Clear space.

When the Lethe logo is used with other logos or other elements, a clear space should be maintained to ensure integrity, legibility and visibility. No other element should fall within this area. Use the height of the letter 't' of the Lethe wordmark as a measuring tool to help maintain clearance.




Minimum size

The minimum size allowed for the use of the logo is 25mm base for the payoff version and 15mm for the non-payoff version.





Main logo



Grayscale variant is allowed



Do not rotate



Do not deform



Do not change the colours



Do not use a different font



Do not apply any effect



Do not apply to backgrounds that hinder readability


